The premise behind the books is not only to entertain children but also remind them the importance of life's virtues such as gratitude, acceptance, integrity, and friendship. For the past year, Jackie has been sharing her stories with school children throughout the county. "Seeing is Beelieving" even caught the attention of television host, columnist and author of "The Secret Life of SuperMom" Kathy Buckworth.

*"The G-Bugs series helps kids understand the differences of others, and in turn accept their own unique qualities. In fact, the books go beyond "acceptance" and encourage children to celebrate who they are, and to appreciate the positives they have in their lives," says Buckworth.*
